44th Annual General Body Meeting

Executive Committee Annual Report – 2022-23

Dear Members,

It gives us immense pleasure to present a report which contains the activities of our chapter for the year 2022-2023.

1) Executive Committee:

The executive committee met four (4) times during the year. All the decisions taken and the suggestions made in the meetings were implemented. The members participated in the meetings with positive and useful contributions.

2) Training Programs:

a) In plant Trainings

During the year forty-seven (47) numbers of In plant Safety Trainings were conducted at various industries in the state benefitting 1763 participants.

The details are mentioned in Part-I of the Annexure.

b) Specialized Public Training

During the year One (1) number of specialized public Safety Training on “Testing & Examination of Lifting Machinery, Lifting Tackles and Pressure Vessels” was conducted on 20.5.2023 for industries benefitting 53 participants.

c) Specialized Public Training in association with Head Quarters, Mumbai

During the year One (1) number of specialized public Safety Training on “Electrical Safety – Regulations & Best Practices” in association with NSCI-Mumbai was conducted on 27 & 28 June 2022 for industries benefitting 35 participants.

3) Safety Audits & Others

The chapter conducted as many as 27 nos. of Safety audits for various industries in the state.

The details are as per Part-II of the Annexure.

4) Safety Calendars 2023

The chapter brought out a 4 sheet bilingual calendars in multi colours this year also depicting safety messages to bring about awareness on safety at the grass root level. 6500 copies were made available to 56 organizations in the state.

5) Fire Services Day / Week – 14 to 20 April-2022

The Fire Services Day/Week was observed from 14th to 20th April 2022. The chapter had banners, posters and tip cards made available to 38 organizations in the state to promote awareness on fire prevention.

6) World Environment Day/Week – 5th June 2022

The World Environment Day was observed on 5th June 2022. The promotional materials such as banners, badges, posters and tip cards were made available to 70 industries in the state highlighting the importance of environment protection.

7) National Electrical Safety Week – 26 June to 2 July-2022

The National Electrical Safety Week was observed from 26th June to 2nd July-2022. The promotional materials such as banners, badges, posters and tip cards were made available to 18 industries in the state highlighting the importance of electrical safety.

7) Chemical Disaster Prevention Day – 4 Dec-2022

The Chemical Disaster Prevention Day was observed on 4th December 2022. The promotional materials such as banners, posters and tip cards were made available to 53 industries in the state highlighting the importance of chemical safety.

8) Road Safety Month – 18 Jan to 17 Feb 2023

The Road Safety Month was observed from 18 Jan to 17 Feb 2023. The promotional materials such as banners, posters and Road Safety CDs were made available to 46 industries in the state highlighting the importance of Road safety.

9) National Safety Day/Week

52nd National Safety Day was celebrated jointly by Karnataka Chapter and Karnataka State Safety Institute and Department of Factories & Boilers, Industrial Safety & Health Government of Karnataka on 4th March, 2023 with great enthusiasm at HAL Management Academy.

The Chapter participated with a safety stall at the venue.

The chapter provided promotional materials such as banners, pens, flags, badges, tip cards, posters, key chains and pouches to 575 organizations in the state.

10) Special efforts made to increase membership

- Chapter observed membership drive during May & June months. Circulars with membership form and services provided sent to 52 industries and 2 individuals in Karnataka State on 16.5.2022.
- The persons visiting the office for purchase of posters and other promotional materials were motivated to become members.
- Appeals were made in the training programs conducted by the chapter to motivate the industries to become members.
