Many industrial operations and processes involve in the use of lifting machinery, lifting tackles and pressure vessels. The condition of these equipments and the manner of their use, have great influence on the efficiency of the operations and processes. Faulty selection, inadequate strength, patent defects, poor operating practices are some of the significant causes for failure of these equipments, some of which result in fatal or serious injuries and damage to equipment, material or other facilities. To avert such unwanted events, it is essential that users of these equipments are familiar with the various requirements relating to the design, construction, testing and examination, maintenance and safe operation of the equipment.

These equipments are to be periodically examined and tested as prescribed under Sections 28, 29 & 31 of the Factories Act-1948 and Rules 61, 62, 63, 64 and 65 of the Karnataka Factories Rules-1969. This program is being organized to provide detailed information of the requirements relating to testing and examination, inspection, maintenance and use of the above equipment.
